**SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL IN SOLANO COUNTY:**

Established in 2008 to address the rate of obesity in children in Solano County, the rate of asthma in children and the increase of vehicle traffic around schools at peak drop off and pick up times.

In 2017, the Solano Safe Routes to School (SR2S) Program received a Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Grant, and used the funds to promote pedestrian and bicycle safety among elementary and middle school youth in Solano County providing helmets, education and presentations at schools and events across the county.

As a follow up to the 2017 OTS Grant, the SR2S Program will engage the community, share information and collaborate with city and county stakeholders to find solutions to make our roadways safer for both youth and adult pedestrians.
