



Solano Safe Routes to School Education and Enforcement Grants

FY 2011-2013

- **Fairfield Police Department: \$33,000**
Directed Enforcement and School Engagement
- **Suisun Police Department: \$67,000**
Development of Crossing Guard Training Materials and School Engagement

FY 2014-2016

- **Vacaville Police Department: \$60,000**
School Engagement, Countywide Implementation of Crossing Guard Training, Directed Enforcement around schools
- **Rio Vista Police Department: \$30,360**
Purchase electronic portable speed and messaging boards, assist in SR2S events (Walk to School and Bike to School Days), school engagement with parents, Crosswalk Safety Enforcement



FY 2016-2018

- **Rio Vista Police Department: \$25,000**
School Engagement rallies for bike/ped safety, Safety Fair for bike/pedestrian safety, and traffic safety for senior drivers, engaging Rio Vista schools and the community, Directed Enforcement
- **Suisun City Police Department: \$125,000**
Hire School Safety Traffic Officer, develop Bicycle Helmet Diversion Program, develop Distracted Driver materials, Directed Enforcement, School Engagement activities

FY 2018-2020

- **Benicia Police Department: \$150,000**
Development of a Community Service Officer position to promote, attend, develop SR2S activities for Benicia Schools, utilize a bicycle helmet diversion program, develop and introduce a “Distracted Road User” campaign for drivers, bicyclists and pedestrians
- **Suisun City Police Department: \$35,600**
Continue traffic/parking enforcement around schools, provide safety education to parents and students, participate in School Engagement activities with part-time School Safety Traffic Officer (SSTO)
